IT'S amazing what a set of hair extensions and some smoky eye make-up can do for a girl's image.

Pop starlet Delta Goodrem's suddenly sexy, long locks have been the talk of Tinseltown in recent weeks, transforming the singer from girl-

next-door to sex symbol.

Mikey Forster of Identity Cut and Colour in South Brisbane says long, voluminous, healthy hair is the look of the moment, but the only way to get it instantly is with hair extensions.

Thankfully, clip-on extensions are now becoming more popular than permanent ones giving you the same look without breaking the budget.

The latest version to hit hairdressing salons is HairDo Salon Clip-In Hair from Jessica Simpson and her hairdresser, Ken Paves.

Available in a synthetic fibre (the cheaper option) or human hair, this is literally a hairpiece which clips easily on to your head and can be colour matched and then cut to suit your natural hairstyle.

Forster says the extensions have already gained a solid following, with many clients loving the natural look of having them cut to look like their own hair. He says people love to be able to change their look on a regular basis and the fact clip-in extensions are easy to do and temporary makes them a perfect choice.

"It's just an accessory now," Forster says.

"It's easy to do at home and it's something you can take in and out."

He predicts clients will soon be requesting Goodrem's new do, but at the moment Jessica Simpson and Mischa Barton's hair are the most popular requests.

The synthetic extensions come in eight different lengths, while the human hair comes in the long form.

There is a choice of curly or straight hair.

**Hairdo Salon Clip-In Hair is available at Identity Cut and Colour and range in price from \$159.95 for short, synthetic extensions to \$549.95 for the human hair extension.**
